PROCUREMENT AND LOGISTICS

Kimberly Langkam will be the Procurement Officer for this project and will be the primary point of contact for questions. Chris Elnicki is the DGS Project Manager. The requirements for the bid can be found on eMaryland Marketplace Advantage (emma.maryland.gov) and are summarized below:

- Source Selection will be based on Competitive Sealed Bids. Submissions are virtual only and no paper bids will be accepted.
 - o The bid includes five (5) line items:
 - Base Bid
 - Four (4) Add-Alternates
 - o Bidders are to submit a bid for all lines.
- Project Classification: "E" (\$2.5-\$5M)
- Questions are due by 20 June 2023 at 2:00 PM. All questions must be submitted in writing to kimberly.langkam@maryland.gov
- Bid Due Date: 27 June 2023 at 2:00 PM
- Teams will have 730 calendar days following award to complete the project, with liquidated damages of \$1,000 per day in overage.
- MBE subcontracting participation is 20% and is a percentage of the total contract value. Proper submission of all forms is critical and will be deemed non-responsive if not submitted.
 - o Refer to Minority Business Enterprise Utilization Procedures February 5, 2021 for further information.
 - Waiver requests may be possible and must be completed prior to bid. These cannot be implemented after bid is awarded.
- VSBE subcontracting participation is 5% and is a percentage of the total contract value.
 - o Additional information is available on eMMA.

CLARIFICATIONS

- 1. MBE Clarifications:
 - Changes may happen following bid if issues arise (problems with contractors, defaults, etc.)
 and must go through the Procurement Office

2. Operations:

- Greenbrier will reduce capacity during construction of the project to facilitate reduced traffic volume during construction. The park WILL REMAIN OPEN during construction.
- The project is located at the only road into the park and traffic flow will be critical to maintain.
- The Camp Registration offices will be relocated during construction and will not be occupied during renovations.
- A ticket booth will be located at the site and will need to be accessible to any patron, especially during high season between Memorial Day and Labor Day.
- The awarded bidder can work with DGS and DNR to coordinate phasing to ensure traffic patterns and access to the park can be maintained. The project team will be open to timeframes, time of year for construction and any logistics with the awarded bidder.
- DNR will be heavily involved in all site logistics and any disruptions to utilities. The transformer serving the site will require upgrades and may affect power to the site.
- The Visitor's Center will be available for Progress Meetings, on a bi-weekly basis. An on-site trailer is not expected nor required.
